Position Summary

Receive and Record the movements of supplies, materials, and equipment in accordance with Liquor Plus policy. Deconstruct shipments and transport to proper storage areas, maintaining a clean and organized receiving area.

Key Responsibilities

- Receive incoming goods, ensuring product received reflects invoice information. Noting all variances between ordered and received quantities as per company policy
- Inspect products received for quality assurance, possible shortages / overages per company policy
- Oversee unloading of product received and proper repackaging and loading of product to be returned
- Create and maintain a well-organized receiving area, keeping a constant knowledge of where all products are being stored, to assist in retrieval
- Deconstruct and unpack shippers in a safe and organized manner as per company policy, into manageable piles, ensuring accessibility for other team members
- Confirm new products are set up in LBoss (Point of sale system) prior to sending to retail floor

Other Related Duties

- Organize receiving layout to ensure clutter and tripping hazards are minimized.
- Operate a hand jack to transport pallets of product safely within receiving area.
- Maintain store cleanliness by ensuring all cleaning schedules are completed in a timely manner and all cleaning policies are followed
- Prioritize abiding by safety policy and procedures established by WCB, Safety Standards Act of BC, and Liquor Plus
- Trains staff on company policies and procedures, enforces policies and monitors staff performance
- Responsible for the intake, and organization, of recyclable materials
